

# Mapping the Palestinian Web Space

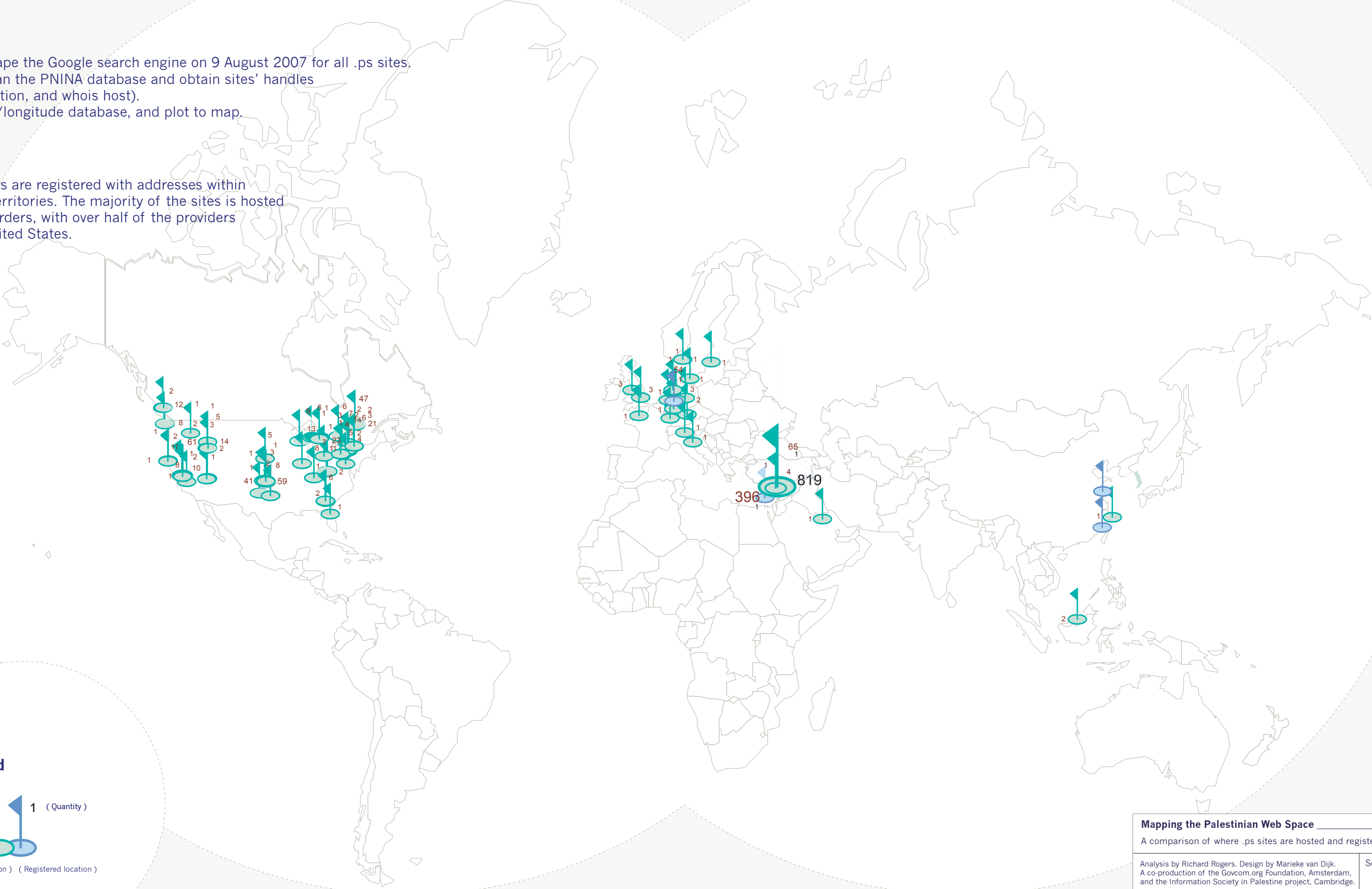
## A comparison of where .ps sites are hosted and registered

### Method

- a) Query and scrape the Google search engine on 9 August 2007 for all .ps sites.
- b) Query and clean the PNINA database and obtain sites' handles (whois registration, and whois host).
- c) Query latitude/longitude database, and plot to map.

### Findings

Nearly all .ps sites are registered with addresses within the Palestinian Territories. The majority of the sites is hosted outside of the borders, with over half of the providers located in the United States.
