


Etisalat blocks, DIC-NET does not.

Etisalat blocks or times out sites in the following categories. (here are some examples)

DIC-NET services the Dubai Technology and Media Free Zone, including the Dubai Internet City, Dubai Media City, Dubai Knowledge Village and other Emaar properties.

It's funny -- you don't get the note about the page being "blocked due to its content being inconsistent with the religious, cultural, political and moral values of the United Arab Emirates," but you just get an error that looks like it's from Skype.

Please try and see if you get the same thing.

I'm in Dubai for a couple of nights right now and can confirm that Skype does not work here. As noted in an earlier post, there's no official warning that it's blocked, instead Skype just acts as though it's not connected to the Internet.
